This week's Revd. Morris' message: I wonder what you may be 'hooked on' at the moment?

Luke is the only Gospel author that relates the calling of Peter, James and

John in depth by including the miraculous fish catch and Jesus' call to become 'Soul Fishers'. What dramatic scenes are captured. Let's put ourselves into Peter's shoes...

Our small family fishing boat and its' exhausted crew has had a hard and spectacularly unsuccessful night on the Lake. Usually, they have a decent catch - but not last night! The family's meagre savings will take a hit today - we will need to tighten our belts. I wonder what I may have done wrong in my preparation? Or is it just bad luck? Or something worse - am I being punished? Anyways, we have closed up shop and are attending to the last back breaking task of cleaning our nets before going home to get some well deserved sleep.

Oh no, here comes that bloke who healed my Mother in Law recently, accompanied by a huge crowd - now he wants my boat! What ...to become a pulpit? I'm going to have to clean it all up again afterwards! Oh well, I guess I owe him something for the old girl's healing ...

What now? **Go out again to fish? What would a carpenter know about fishing?** I tell you it's the wrong time .. and the wrong place to fish! Oh well, if He says so - he seems to have the knack of performing the miraculous - and that is exactly what it will take!


What is this? Fish Galore! Yahoo! James, John - quickly, let's take all that we can!

Hang on That bloke just did another miracle - again, right before my eyes! This is God stuff right here! Who am I to be here, see this ... and be enriched by it? I know exactly the sort of man I am ... and I'm not the sort that He would wish to be around if He knew who I really was ... and if He did get to know all those things I did and thought ... I am so ashamed ... What could Jesus do to me? What punishment would He decree?

But ... Jesus said : **Don't be afraid ... From now on you will be 'fishing for souls' ...** "And as soon as they landed, they left everything and went with him" ...

Well, what does this all mean for us today?

The Greek word for fishing or "catching" used here by Luke ('zogron') is rarely used in the New Testament. It means "to catch alive" **Peter, the fisherman, had himself become** well and truely 'Hooked' on Jesus. Jesus didn't ask Peter to go away, do penance, sign on to a Cod of Beliefs and Conduct, then clean up his act and come back in a week or



two. He just said ...
come as you are and
be with me. Peter's
encounter with Jesus
literally changed his life
... and his vocation ..
entirely. Peter
experienced in Jesus a
Divine encounter which
embraced him 'just as
he was', accepted him
and offered him a new
way of being ... simply

living with Jesus, learning His ways and seeking to follow wherever He leads... and helping others to get 'hooked on Jesus' too. But the purpose of this type of 'catching' wasn't so that 'the catch' would be killed ... but rather that they are to then become truely alive .. the people that they were meant to be and become!

I wonder if you are currently feeling as if your nets always seem to come up empty? I wonder what or who you may be 'hooked on' at the moment? I wonder if you are ready to be more fully 'caught up' in Jesus? ... and perhaps also ready to share your faith in a way that it may be 'caught' by those you love and meet? **Gospel reading: Luke 5: 1-11 Some resources to dig deeper:** https://www.workingpreacher.org/commentaries/narrative-lectionary/great-catch-of-fish/commentary-on-luke-51-11-2.
